

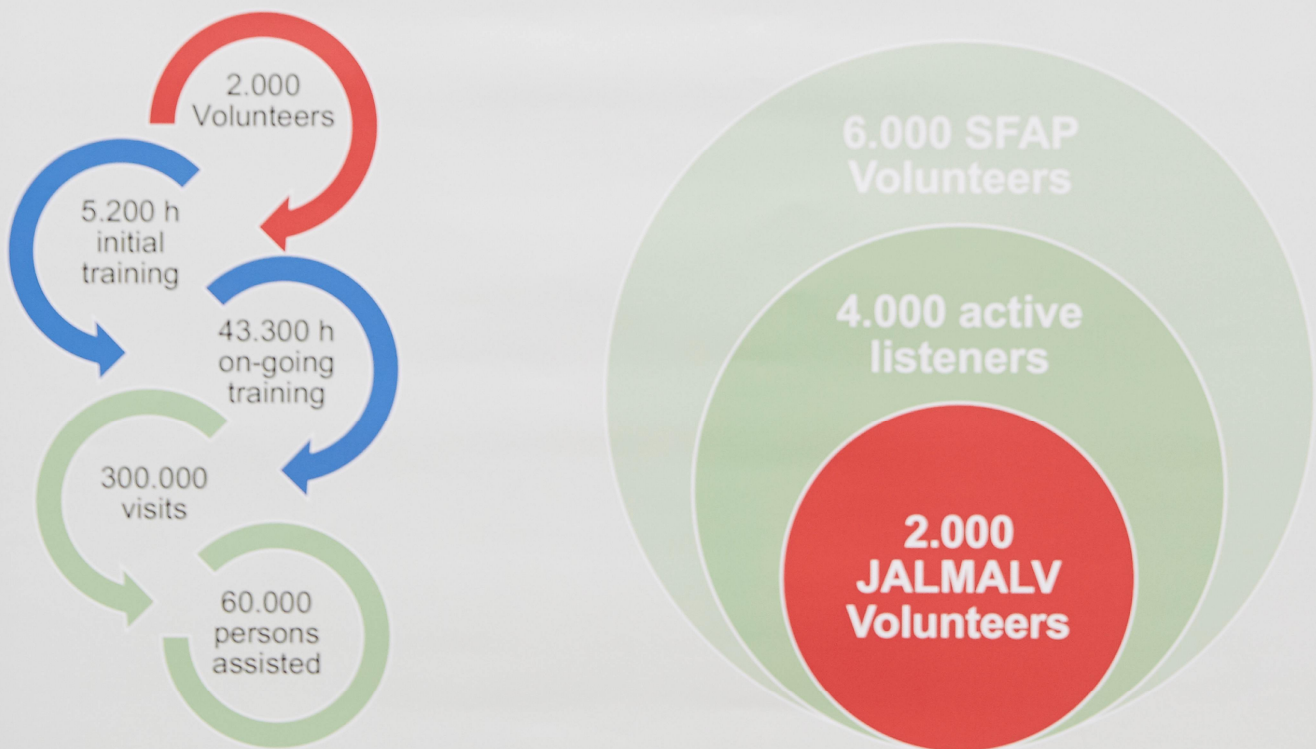
CHOOSING ONLY TO LISTEN
